

DISTRICT 5330 RESOLUTION 2026

NOMINATING COMMITTEE

Whereas

the role of the Nominating Committee shall be to annually call for nominations for the office of District Governor and conduct the selection for this office as well as the Representative to the Council on Legislation, and a Vice-Governor for the Governor Elect, and

Whereas

In order for the District to create a more democratic selection process by creating a committee with more diversity and membership participation, and

Whereas

The current committee is composed of only Past District Governors the exclusivity of which precludes representation of the membership in the participation of selecting their leaders in the democratic voting process, and

Whereas

The development of a three year termed committee consisting of the District Governor, Immediate Past District Governor, District Governor Elect and District Governor Nominee, and by a drawing, three additional Past District Governors (who reside in the district, are in good standing in a district club, are active by attending significant district events or chairing district committees, Avenues of Service, or other district events for the prior three years), the Executive Assistant Governor (EAG), five Assistant Governors (selected by the EAG from the four main regions of the District and voted on by the Governor line), three past club presidents (drawn from a list of Governor's Citation winners from the prior year), will accomplish democratic inclusion, therefore,

Resolved

That the new committee structure be approved as it will create a democratic election process for the entire membership to participate in the selection of their leadership creating an increased sense of ownership in and commitment to the workings of their Rotary District and Rotary Clubs.
